CHART ANOMALY RECOGNITION: The technical profile for SHORT TERM INVESTING displays a well-defined volume profile gap correlating with NYSE Trading Floor Data.

VOLATILITY PROFILE: Analysis of the Average True Range (ATR) on SHORT TERM INVESTING suggests that institutional market makers are widening spreads for short term investing ahead of a projected 12% expansion velocity loop.
