

**RIDER OF ACCESSION TO THE AGREEMENT FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE  
IJL LECZ CARE**

**BETWEEN**

**The French National Research Institute for Sustainable Development**, hereinafter referred to as “**IRD**”, a public establishment of a scientific and technological nature, SIRET No. 180006025 00159, APE code 7219Z, whose registered office is at 44, boulevard de Dunkerque CS 90009 13572 Marseille Cedex 02, Represented by its Chairwoman and Chief Executive Officer, Dr. Valérie Verdier,

**AND**

The **Centre National de la Recherche Scientifique**, hereinafter referred to as “**CNRS**”, a scientific and technological public establishment, having its registered office at 3 rue Michel Ange 75016 Paris, FRANCE, represented by its Chairman and CEO, Mr. Antoine PETIT, and by delegation of signature by Mr. Alain Schuhl, Deputy Director for Science,

hereinafter referred to individually as the “Party” or jointly the “Parties”,

Considering the agreement for the creation of the IJL LECZ-CARE concluded on the 29<sup>th</sup> November 2020, hereinafter referred to as the “Agreement”, and, in particular, the provisions of its Article 3.2, pursuant to which the parties to the Agreement give authority to the IRD for the purposes of concluding any rider to it regarding accession of the said IJL;

The Parties agree as follows:

**Article I – Purpose**

The purpose of this amendment is to formalise the CNRS's membership of the IJL LECZ-CARE and defines the terms of payment of the CNRS's financial contribution to the LMI.

The CNRS expressly undertakes to respect the stipulations of the Agreement.

It is expressly acknowledged that CNRS shall have the same rights as all the other Parties, especially relating to the conditions of access to the Laboratory Council and to the Assessment Committee.

**Article II - Terms and conditions for the provision of funds**

The annual financial contribution of the CNRS to the LMI is set at 5,000 € (five thousand euros). From the date of its accession, and for the remaining duration of the Agreement, the total contribution of the CNRS amounts to 15,000 € (fifteen thousand euros).

Subject to performance and availability of funds, the CNRS undertakes to pay the annual financial contribution to the UMR5001 “Institut des géosciences de l’environnement (IGE)”, french laboratory involved in the project.

**Article III – Effective date**

This rider comes into force on the date of signature by the last Party and will take effect until the end of the Agreement.

**Article IV – Various**

The stipulations of the Agreement not modified by this rider shall remain applicable and effective in full.
